Over the course of several decades, the Schaefer name has been stevedoring along the Gulf for imports into the industrial regions of Mexico. We began with a single, general cargo terminal operation in the Port of Brownsville, handling mostly steel destined for Monterrey. Since then, our stevedoring origin has allowed us to expand our reach into trucking, rail, and ocean freight. Today, Schaefer services now encompass every major transportation mode in Mexico.

Our stevedoring operations are located along the Gulf of Mexico in Brownsville, Corpus Christi, Altamira, Tampico, and Veracruz. However, we do routinely bundle services in other ports in Mexico, mostly along the Pacific Coast ports of Manzanillo and Lazaro Cardenas.

Our objective is to offer accuracy and reliability to trading companies, mill producers, and manufacturers operating within Mexico's growing industrial markets.

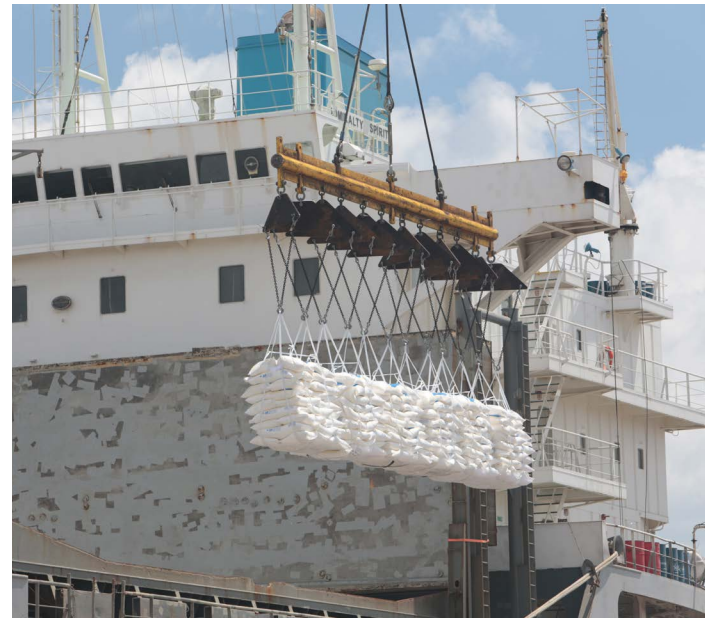
